 751 followers by the end of the Key Club year.
 - b. Increase the number of Club Directories received by 30%.
- 2. **KEY CLUB GROWTH**: Reactivate or charter a new Kiwanis
 Family Club in each region of the New England and
 Bermuda District by the end of the Key Club year.
- DATA COLLECTION: Get a better understanding of Key Clubs in our District by increasing Secretary Report submission by 30%.
- 4. **COPI**: Raise \$18,000 for the San Sa Ho dormitory before the end of the 2020-2021 Key Club year by raising awareness through social media and newsletters.
- 5. **DECON AWARENESS**: Make DECON more accessible by publishing educational resources so 8 Key Clubs that haven't attended in 4 years or more register.
