# See ya, Seniors! Oh, wait... The K- Family



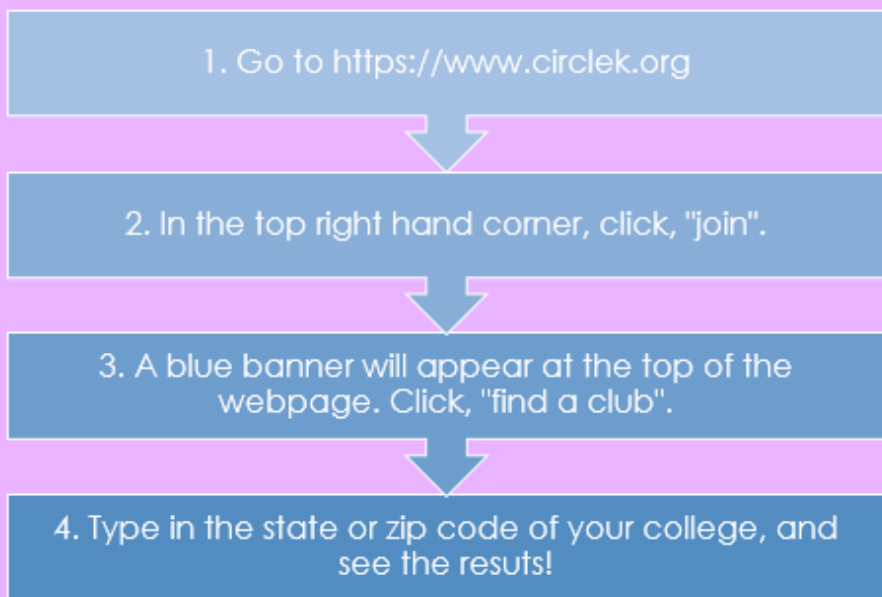
Congrats! You graduated. Not only are you leaving your school, but you are moving on from Key Club. Don't worry, you can still be part of the K-Family!
