Duties of a LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

aka an ITGI

If you're interested in running to be the next Lieutenant Governor of Division 5, read below! The caucus will be **January 12** in the **conference room** at the **Eastern Slope Inn** in **North Conway**. We'll start at **12:00**! Each Key Club can send one candidate and 2 voting delegates. If you have more than one candidate from your Key Club, please have a mini-election within your Key Club to eliminate all but one candidate (we wish we could take everyone, though!). Potential candidates please come to the Divisional Council Meeting (see below) to learn more about how this will work!

- NEBD District Board Member- attend Board trainer in April and Board meetings in August, October, and the day before DECON. Attend International Convention (optional, but recommended) and DECON before and after your term!
- **Communication-** stay in touch with Key Club officers and advisors through newsletters and emails.
- Monthly Reporting- submit a report of the 9 Key Clubs
 by the 10th of each month (like a secretary report)
- Face-to-Face contact- visit all 9 Key Clubs, once or +!
- Officer Training- Hold a Regional Training Conference to train officers, and host meetings throughout the year to assist officers and advisors.

- **Committee Work** serve on 2 committees on the District Board and complete a monthly assignment.
- Divisional Function-hold a meeting pertaining to service for all Key Clubs.
- Service- complete 50 hours of community service
- Other-remind and help Key Clubs to pay dues, submit secretary reports, etc., answer all emails within 7 days, represent Key Club at various functions as necessary, complete other assignments from the Executive Board and District Administrators.

Please keep in mind that you do get a discount on conventions and are partially reimbursed for all travel!
