**MEMBERSHIP COMMITMENT**

- Members are encouraged to attend meetings on a regular basis and to participate in club service projects.
- There is a one-time membership fee of \$25. Semi-annual dues currently are set at \$39 and billed on February and August 1st of each year. First year dues are prorated.
- This amount covers all International, New England District, and club fees, which include International, district, and club publications and liability insurance coverage.
- A buffet dinner is served by Contigiani's Catering. Meals are \$10 per meeting and are paid whether attended or not. Uneaten meal monies are deposited into the club's administrative account.

**CLUB STRUCTURE**

The club officers and eight directors manage the club's business. The Board of Directors meets after the first regular meeting of each month.

**MEETING PROTOCOL**

The business meeting is opened with the ringing of the Kiwanis bell, followed by an invocation, Pledge of Allegiance, and a patriotic song. Meetings are fun, social, informative, and educational.
